REGISTRATION

A child must be registered latest by the end of November, if admission is sought for in April of the following year, on the enclosed registration form. The Common Aptitude Assessment (CAA) is held in the third week of January. The academic session begins in the month of April. **Registration in no way ensures admission of the child**, it is subject to clearing the Common Aptitude Assessment (CAA). Only registered candidates will be considered for CAA.

ADMISSION

After Registration candidates will be notified the date of Common Aptitude Assessment and an interaction of the child along with his/her parents with the Principal. As the medium of instruction is English, an understanding of English as well as an English speaking capability, is a must for all applicants. Candidates qualifying in the Common Aptitude Assessment will be granted admission, subject to the availability of seats. No admission is granted unless all the requirements are fulfilled. The Admission Committee reserves the right to admit the candidates based on their performance in the Common Aptitude Assessment, interviews, personality, intelligence and other capabilities. The decision of the Admission Committee will be final and binding in all cases. If a candidate fails to appear in the admission test/interview, his/her registration will lapse and the registration fee will be forfeited. However, the admission committee may consider, if justified.

Once the candidate is granted admission, he/she is required to fulfill all the formalities and pay the necessary fees within 15 days. If he/she fails to do so, the school is free to offer the seat to another candidate. Every child is required to submit a fitness certificate by an MBBS doctor.

The school, however reserves the right to decide the class in which a child may be placed on admission. The Principal does not bind himself/ herself to furnish any reason for the rejection of any application for admission. A child joining from any other school must carry his/her Transfer Certificate from the previous school accompanied by a Birth Certificate from the Municipality/committee authorities. The date of birth as declared at the time of admission cannot be altered later in the school records.

The minimum age of admission in Play Group is 2.5 years as on 1st April.

Note: At the time of going to press, June 2022, the information given is accurate but is liable to change. This is not a legal document, hence any information or claims herein are not subject to legal jurisdiction. Disputes are subject to Dehradun courts only.



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SCHOOL UNIFORM

School Uniforms will be out sourced as per the measurement of the child on actual cost. On being granted admission, new students are sent a clothing list, detailing the articles to be brought to the school by each child. Parents must ensure that exact number of articles required are sent with the child. The school has the right to confiscate any article which is not mentioned in the list. Any article which is confiscated will not be returned. We encourage a sense of equality and parents are advised not to send any expensive personal items to school with their children since the school will not, under any circumstance take responsibility for the loss of such items.

SCHOOL TERMS

There are two school terms each year, from April to September and from October to March. A child joining or leaving in the middle of a year has to pay the whole year's fees.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WHY CO-EDUCATION ?

It is a more natural environment to grow in and also affords siblings equal opportunity for quality education in the same school.

WHY RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL ?

It offers the child an opportunity to grow and bloom as an individual and a confident person with a well groomed personality who makes his own mark without bringing into consideration the parent's economic and social status.

RULES

Any child found habitually stealing, cheating, in possession of illegal tuck, cash or forbidden items, deliberate and persistent absence from classes, prep, games, hobbies and activities, breaking school property, telling lies, rude and disobedient, not punctual, disturbing teachers or classmates during class or prep, using improper language, late after an outing or vacations, or showing any other display of bad conduct will be liable to punishment.

Deliberate disobedience and display of bad conduct will be punishable by means of issuing a Yellow Card, Red Card or Blue Card in the morning school assembly.

A Yellow Card received means warning, a chance to improve.

A Yellow Card received second time means last warning before suspension.

A Red Card received means suspension for 3 to 7 days as the case may be.

A Red Card received for the second time means expulsion. If a child is expelled and the fees has already been paid will be forfeited. No dialogue will be entertained in this regard. The Principal's decision will be final and binding.

A Blue Card received means he/she needs to work hard and improve a lot in academics in order to be promoted to the next class.

Students are expected to follow a high moral code of conduct. The school renders adequate guidance and counseling towards following good behavior and high ethical life. If any student break rules or indulges in anti social activities he/she will be liable to disciplinary action and expulsion from the school.

If a child is found in possession of a mobile phone will be immediately expelled from the school and the parents will be called for. Re admission fees has to be deposited in case the child wishes to continue in the institution.

TELEPHONE CALLS AND LETTER WRITING

Each student is given a chance to call his/her parents from his/her registered telephone code for fifteen minutes on a scheduled day in a week. Students are encouraged to write letters and parents are requested to reciprocate by writing to them regularly.





GENERAL RULES

ACHIEVEMENTS AND AWARDS

1. Aryan Spirit Trophy is for Good conduct. This is awarded to a child, who is kind and generous and has shown good conduct in every sphere during his/her stay in the institution.
2. Student of The Year is for the best student. This is awarded to a child who has excelled in academics and displayed high level of discipline in the institution by dint of his/her extraordinary good behaviour, following school rules at all times and has shown a sense of belongingness to the institution.
3. The Aryan Star Trophy is for all round excellence. This prestigious trophy is awarded to a child who the Principal chooses for displaying excellence in all three areas of achievement, i.e. academics, games/sports and co-curricular activities.

HONOURS CARDS

To enable the students to continually strive for academic excellence, the students are awarded with 'Honours Cards' twice in an academic session i.e. after the Half Yearly and Annual Examination. The details of the 'Honours Cards' are as follows:

SECOND HONOURS : If a child, scores 60% to 69% in all the subjects in the Half Yearly and Annual Examination, he/she will be awarded 'Second Honours'.

FIRST HONOURS : If a child, scores 70% to 79% in all the subjects in the Half Yearly and Annual Examination, he/she will be awarded 'First Honours'.

DISTINCTION : If a child, scores 80% to 89% in all the subjects in the Half Yearly and Annual Examination, he/she will be awarded 'Distinction'.

PAR EXCELLENCE : If a child, scores 90% and above in all the subjects in the Half Yearly and Annual Examination, he/she will be awarded the most Prestigious Honours card 'Par Excellence'.

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT/EXCELLENCE

1. Certificate of Merit/Excellence is awarded for academics/games activities/co-curricular activities/good conduct.
2. An Academic proficiency Certificate is awarded for excellent results.
3. A "Games Achievement Certificate" is awarded to a child who has done outstandingly well in a particular game.
4. An academic blazer is awarded to the topper of class VIII and X (ICSE)
5. A sports blazer is awarded to a student who is an all rounder in sports.

Criteria for promotion to the next class, under normal circumstances, a child must not fail in any subject, The pass percentage is 50%. There will be 2 assessments and two examinations in the academic session. A student must pass on the average with 50% or above in each subject.

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HOSTEL FACILITIES AND RULES

The school has state of the art boarding house in separate buildings for girls, junior boys and senior boys equipped with all modern amenities and facilities. The hostel block features individual and collective space for rest and study. It is designed to provide each child a feeling of security and comfort. The rooms are airy and washrooms scrupulously clean with hot and cold water supply.

Food

Multi-cuisine vegetarian & non-vegetarian food is provided to the students. The menu includes Indian, Continental and Chinese cuisine. Milk is served twice a day. The weekly menu keeps changing to avoid monotony. The food committee consisting of senior children, makes the menu. To keep pupils in good health, the Mess Manager supervises all kitchen operations. The residential staff eats along with the children.

Health And Care

The school takes special care of the students' health and has on its panel specialized and competent doctors. The school hostel has competent staff consisting of matrons, housemasters and trained nurses who live on the campus. Parents are informed of the child's health if he/she is confined to bed for more than three days. In case of emergency, the Principal reserves the right to use his/her discretion to authorize required medical treatment and the use of anesthesia in the interest of the child's health. The school has an arrangement with a reputed hospital very close by, to cater to emergencies.

Visiting Hours

The boarders are allowed Sunday outings according to the schedule given in the school calender. Parents/Guardians are requested to take the children out only on outing days and adhere to the timings. No parent will be allowed inside the campus to meet his/her child/ward without the permission of the Principal. In case of an emergency, the parents are requested to contact either the Principal or the House Master.

No eatables of any nature from outside are allowed into the campus.

Transport Arrangement

The school arranges to drop the boarders to New Delhi Airport during Summer and Winter vacation only. The school makes transport arrangement for this purpose and the children are sent with an escort till the airport or whatever the destination be. They are also received on arrival. An advance notice of two weeks has to be given to the school for this facility.

Mid Term

Excursions are compulsory for the students in the mid term break, when they are sent for age appropriate expeditions with school staff. Children are taught survival skills and respect for nature. Adventure activities are provided on certain weekends.









GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

A newspaper advertisement announcing the availability of seats may, at the discretion of the Principal, be released three to four months before the academic year is scheduled to commence. Prospective parents are welcome to visit the school on any working day during office hours i.e. 9 A.M - 5 P.M and may register their child for admission into a particular class.

A non-refundable registration fee, will be charged from the candidate applying for registration on the prescribed registration form. The mere act of registration will not constitute a guarantee of admission, which is subject to assessment, interview and the rules contained there in. All candidates will be required to register, following the registration procedure above and only registered candidates will be eligible for assessment.

ADMISSION IN CLASS XI

A child may be admitted provisionally in April in one of the three streams i.e. Humanities, Science & Commerce with or without Mathematics. The admission and subjects are confirmed only after the declaration of the board result at the end of May. The School will admit those candidates whose class X results are declared before 31st July of the on going academic year. Candidates seeking admission to class XI of the ISC (XII) course, who have passed their class X Examination from the National Institute of Open Schooling, New Delhi, must fulfill the following criteria: -

- a. Pass in five written subjects of external examination.
- b. These five subjects must include English, a second language and three other written subjects accepted by the Council.
- c. Passed the examination in one and the same academic year.

PROCEDURE

Candidates who are offered admission must avail the offer within the specified time by paying the necessary admission fees, as defined in the current year's Fee structure and returning duly signed the Indemnity Agreement (on Judicial Stamp Paper), the Uniform measurement chart and the Student's medical history form, T.C. and Report Card of previous school and 5 Passport size Photographs failing which the admission may not be granted. In such cases, the school will be entitled to offer the place to another candidate in order of merit/position in the waiting list.

THE ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

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At the Aryan School, the child is the center of the world and all activities are arranged around him/her. THIRD LANGUAGE

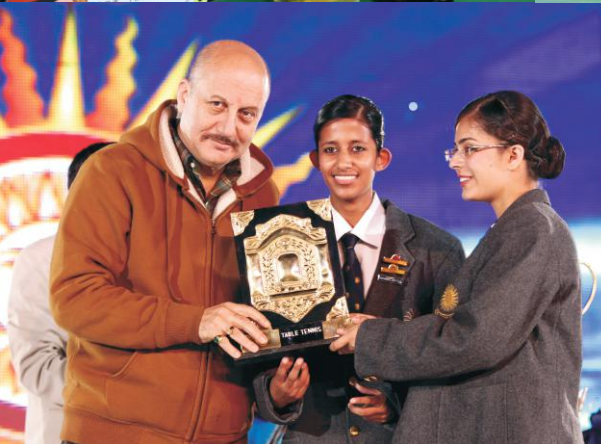
A third language acceptable to the Examination Board is compulsory from standard V to VIII.

ACTIVITIES & FACILITIES

To develop a healthy mind in a healthy body, the school lays particular stress on extra and co-curricular activities. Every child is required to be involved in a variety of activities necessary for his/her all-round development. The school has excellent facilities for sports and games such as Football, Hockey, Cricket, Badminton, Table Tennis, Yoga, Athletics, Swimming, Basketball, Shooting, Lawn Tennis, Karate etc. The school also has various clubs-theatre, debate, nature, walk, social service, music, art & craft and adventure. Regular Inter-House activities are organized to develop a competitive spirit in the children and to bring out the best in them. Regular trips are planned to enhance and extend classroom learning. This allows the students to discover their own sense of individuality and creativity.

The school has a well-stocked library complete with books not only relating to the course material but also all subjects ranging from general knowledge to science, fiction, astronomy, religion, sports etc. The school library is a place for students where they can pursue their intellectual pursuits without submitting to any regime, or conventional classroom methods of instruction.

The library is also connected via the Internet to all the major libraries of the world, this allows the students to pursue their interests and enquiries. Apart from these, science laboratories, computer laboratories, art & craft laboratories are the facilities to promote practical learning.





SCHEDULE FOR DAY BOARDERS

Students have extended hours to stay in the school after 1:30 p.m. Day Boarding facility is provided where the children are exposed to plethora of activities besides academics. This is a platform for the children, while accomplishing their goals they learn to be independent and acquire skills in different fields.

Students at day boarding are put in a separate hostel where they are provided with individual cupboards and beds. A balanced and nutritious diet is prepared under hygienic conditions for lunch.

Children like to take a nap after lunch. Games are an integral part of their daily schedule. On Saturday and Sunday the children pursue a hobby of their choice.

Day boarders are participants of most of the co-curricular activities. Like Inter House and Inter School activities and sports.

STEPS TO BE FOLLOWED BY DAY BOARDER AND BOARDER PARENTS FROM REGISTRATION TO ADMISSION:

Welcome to The Aryan School

- Step 1 Purchase of Prospectus Costing Rs. 500/- (including fee structure, registration & admission form). [For your convenience we can also send the Prospectus by VPP]
- Step 2 Please read the prospectus and specially the rules carefully.
- Step 3 Only the Registration form is to be filled. An attested copy of his/her birth certificate, latest report card (photocopy) and 3 recent passport size coloured photographs of the child may be submitted or posted with the Registration form along with a Demand Draft of Rs. 10,000/- in favour of The Aryan School.
- Step 4 Admit card and a letter informing date & timing for Common Aptitude Assessment will be sent by courier along with the syllabus.
- Step 5 You are required to come to the school along with the child, carrying the admit card for the CAA at the time & date mentioned in the letter. This assessment may take maximum 3 hrs from class I to VIII, for senior classes. Test timings depend upon subject stream chosen. (The child must bring his/her own writing material)
- Step 6 While your child is taking the Common Aptitude Assessment you are required to fill up a questionnaire giving us details of your family and ward. Next you will be called for an interaction for 10 minutes, with the Principal.
- Step 7 The result will be declared after a week of conducting CAA, you will be informed through a confirmation letter which will be sent to you along with the fee bill.
- Step 8 In case your child is granted admission to The Aryan family, fees is to be paid in the Accounts Department as mentioned in the bill. The fees must be deposited by Demand Draft only, by the last date intimated to you in the bill. If the fees is not remitted by the specified time it will be understood that you are not interested and the seat will be given to the next child on the waiting list.
